8 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

9 1. § 1. *The Secretary of Veterans and Defense Affairs and the Secretary of Commerce and Trade (the*
10 *Secretaries), in conjunction with the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity, shall examine*
11 *the waiving of fees associated with permits necessary to establish a small business for veteran-owned*
12 *small businesses. The Secretaries shall identify the necessary permits and determine the total costs of*
13 *associated fees for a start-up by type of business and by regulatory agency and shall determine the*
14 *feasibility of waiving any such fees for veteran-owned small businesses. In conducting their examination,*
15 *the Secretaries may also identify and make recommendations regarding removing other regulatory*
16 *barriers for veteran-owned small businesses. The Secretaries shall report their findings and*
17 *recommendations to the Chairs of the House Committees on Appropriations and Labor and Commerce*
18 *and the Senate Committees on Finance and Appropriations and Commerce and Labor by December 1,*
19 *2022.*

20 *For the purposes of this act:*

21 *"Permit" means the whole or part of any state agency permit, license, certificate, approval,*
22 *registration, charter, or any form or permission required by law to engage in activity associated with or*
23 *involving the establishment of a small business in the Commonwealth.*

24 *"Regulatory" means all permitting and other governmental or statutory requirements establishing a*
25 *small business or professional activities associated with establishing a small business.*

26 *"Regulatory agency" means any state agency, board, commission, or division that regulates one or*
27 *more professions, occupations, industries, businesses, or activities.*

28 *"Small business" means an independently owned and operated business that, together with affiliates,*
29 *has 250 or fewer employees or average annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged over the*
30 *previous three years.*

31 *"Veteran" means an individual who has served in the active military, naval, or air service and who*
32 *was discharged or released therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable.*
