3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Certain family life education curricula; optional instruction on human trafficking.

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Education to include in curriculum guidelines for family life education age-appropriate instruction on the prevention of the human trafficking of children. The bill permits any family life education curriculum offered by a local school division in high school to incorporate age-appropriate elements of effective and evidence-based programs on the prevention, recognition, and awareness of human trafficking of children.
