3. Committee: Public Safety

4. Title: Local correctional facilities; fees.

5. Summary: This bill requires the State Board of Local and Regional Jails (the Board) to convene a work group to study the reduction or elimination of certain fees associated with inmates in local correctional facilities. The bill requires that the work group must include two members of the House Committee on Public Safety who are not members of the same political party and two members of the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services who are not members of the same political party. The bill sets out that the legislative members must appoint other work group members who are representatives of incarcerated offenders and certain organizations or companies. The bill requires the Board to report its findings and recommendations to the Chairmen of the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services and the House Committee on Public Safety by October 1, 2022.
