3. Committee: Public Safety

4. Title: Receipt of critically missing adult reports; Virginia Critically Missing Adult Alert Program.

5. Summary: Expands the definition of “critically missing adult” to include any missing adult 18 years old or older who has a developmental disability, intellectual disability, or mental illness. Current law defines a “critically missing adult” as someone 21 years of age or older whose disappearance poses a credible threat to their health and safety.
