4. Title: Board of Medicine; implicit bias and cultural competency.

5. Summary: Requires all practitioners licensed by the Board of Medicine to complete two hours of continuing education in each biennium on topics related to implicit bias and cultural competency.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Health Professions. The Board of Medicine would need to send out notifications of the requirement, however, that can be accomplished electronically within existing resources.
