**3. Committee:** General Laws

**4. Title:** Sports betting; Virginia college sports.

**5. Summary:** Allows betting, with the exception of proposition betting, on Virginia college sports. Under current law, betting other than proposition betting is allowed on all college sports except Virginia college sports.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate – see Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Virginia Lottery, the proposed legislation is expected to increase wager activity, which would increase sports betting revenues. However, the expected increase in sports betting revenues cannot be determined at this time because some wagering may transition from other currently allowable wager types, and the program is still in very early stages of development.
