3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Board of Education; appointment of nonvoting student advisor.

5. Summary: Requires the Governor to appoint to the Board of Education a high school student who will enter his senior year during the following school year as a nonvoting student advisor to serve for a term of one year. The bill provides that no such student is eligible to be reappointed.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary, see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Education estimates that the cost for meal and travel reimbursement for a non-voting student member of the Board of Education would be \$2,700, based on a per meeting allowance of \$300. The Department of Education would have to absorb this cost within existing resources.
