4. Title: Prohibition on use of show-up identification by law-enforcement officers.

5. Summary: Defines “show-up identification” as an identification procedure in which an eyewitness is presented with a single suspect or single photograph of a suspect for the purpose of determining whether the eyewitness identifies such suspect as the perpetrator. The bill prohibits the use of show-up identification by a law enforcement officer, and prohibits any evidence discovered or obtained as a result of using this method from being admissible in court.
