4. Title: Notice and sale prior to discontinuing natural gas utility service; municipal corporation.

5. Summary: Prior to any municipal corporation generally discontinuing natural gas utility service to any residential, commercial, or industrial customer, the municipal corporation shall provide at least three years' notice and attempt to negotiate the sale of its system facilities and associated rights within two years. If no sale is accomplished within two years, the municipal corporation may offer its system facilities and associated rights by auction.

Copies of all publications of notice related to discontinuing service and the sale of system facilities shall be provided to the State Corporation Commission at the time they are made.
