3. Committee: Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

4. Title: Living shorelines.

5. Summary: Amends the definition of living shorelines to include low crested armoring, defined in the bill. The bill also requires the Marine Resources Commission to publish annually on its website a summary of the percentages of different living shoreline approaches contained in permitted projects.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill may result in an indeterminate increase in the number of projects that qualify for Virginia Clean Water Revolving Loan Fund assistance. It is anticipated that any fiscal impact on the Department of Environmental Quality or the Marine Resources Commission as a result of this bill can be absorbed within existing resources.
