5. Summary: Postpones the scheduled expiration of the Commission on Electric Utility Regulation from July 1, 2022, to July 1, 2024.

8. Fiscal Implications: HB30, as introduced, includes \$10,011, from the general fund each year to support the operations of Commission on Electric Utility Regulation; it is anticipated that any costs that may be incurred in implementing this bill can be absorbed within those resources.
