3. Committee: Passed the House

4. Title: Virginia Stormwater Management Programs; regional industrial facility authorities.

5. Summary: Authorizes a locality that administers a Virginia Stormwater Management Program or a Virginia Erosion and Stormwater Management Program to administer the program on authority property, in accordance with an agreement entered into with all relevant localities and the existing program for the property.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) anticipates an indeterminate fiscal impact as a result of this bill. DEQ anticipates a slight workload reduction related to land-disturbing activities in which DEQ currently operates the Stormwater Management Program (SMP), and in which the land-disturbing activity is located on property controlled by a regional industrial facility authority (RIFA), and where a participating RIFA locality member also operates a SMP. At this time, DEQ is aware of one RIFA that meets the proposed criteria.
