4. Title: Nursing homes, assisted living facilities, etc.; SHHR to study consolidating oversight/regulation

5. Summary: The enrolled bill directs the Secretary of Health and Human Resources to study the current oversight and regulation of nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and other congregate living settings to improve efficiency and effectiveness of regulation and oversight, provide better transparency for members of the public navigating the process of receiving services from such facilities, and better protect the health and safety of the public. The Secretary must report their findings by October 1, 2022.
