3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: Housing and Supportive Services ILT initiative; housing and services for older citizens.

5. Summary: Directs the Department for Housing and Community Development to expand the existing Housing and Supportive Services Interagency Leadership Team (ILT) initiative to include older Virginians as a target subpopulation and seek input from appropriate stakeholders to facilitate the development of strategies for increasing the supply of permanent supportive housing for older Virginians. This bill is a recommendation of the Joint Commission on Health Care.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Housing and Community Development coordinates the Housing and Supportive Services Interagency Leadership Team (ILT). This legislation would require the ILT to include older Virginians as a target subpopulation. This action can be done with current resources.
