4. **Title:** Limited liability companies; prepayment of annual registration fees.

5. **Summary:** Permits domestic and foreign limited liability companies to prepay annual registration fees for two or three years. Under this bill, the Commission is authorized to establish a process for online prepayment of annual registration fees that allows a domestic or foreign limited liability company to prepay its annual registration fees for two or three years. The bill requires that, if applicable, the Commission provide notice of this prepayment option to a foreign or domestic limited liability company that has failed to pay its annual registration fee as a method of avoiding future delinquencies.
