**4. Title:** Disabled veteran special license plate; surviving spouse.

**5. Summary:** This bill authorizes a disabled veteran special license plate issued to a disabled veteran to be transferred, upon his death, to his unremarried surviving spouse.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item #8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Section 46.2-739 of the Code of Virginia requires the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to issue special license plates to applicants who are veterans who have been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs to have a service-connected disability or unremarried surviving spouses of disabled veterans as defined in § 46.2-100. This bill amends Subsection A of § 46.2-739 to make clear that “[a]ny special license plate issued to a disabled veteran pursuant to this subsection may be transferred, upon his death, to his unremarried surviving spouse.”

There is no anticipated fiscal or operational impact to the Department of Motor Vehicles since this is already done pursuant to existing language.
