4. Title: Human trafficking; training for law-enforcement personnel.

5. Summary: The bill requires the Department of Criminal Justice Services to establish training standards for law-enforcement personnel regarding trauma-informed training for the recognition, prevention, and reporting of human trafficking.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Criminal Justice Services, the proposed legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the agency operations. Currently, the agency provides trauma-informed training for the recognition, prevention, and reporting of human trafficking.
