2. Patron: Greenhalgh

3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Voter registration; list maintenance; lists of decedents transmitted by State Registrar.

5. Summary: Requires the State Registrar of Vital Records to transmit to the Department of Elections a weekly list of decedents from the previous week. Currently, this list is transmitted monthly. The bill requires the general registrars to use the information in the lists and promptly cancel the registration of a person known to be deceased or otherwise disqualified to vote.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: As stand-alone legislation, the Department of Elections considers implementation of this bill as “routine,” and does not require additional funding. This bill is also not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Elections, State Board of Elections, Virginia Department of Health, and localities (General Registrars and Electoral Boards).

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The Senate substitute is identical to the engrossed version of SB 211.
