**4. Title:** School Breakfast Program and National School Lunch Program; processing of applications.

**5. Summary:** Requires each public elementary or secondary school to process each web-based or paper-based application for participation in the School Breakfast Program or the National School Lunch Program administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture within six working days after the date of receipt of the completed application. This requirement has a delayed effective date of August 1, 2023. Requires school divisions that cannot currently comply with this requirement to develop a plan for ensuring compliance by August 1, 2023.
