4. Title: Vehicle safety inspection; exhaust system.

5. Summary: Provides that no motor vehicle shall be issued a safety inspection approval sticker if it violates § 46.2-1049(A), which requires the exhaust system to be in good working order.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of State Police (VSP), the agency's motor vehicle inspection program troopers would need decibel meters to measure the noise output of a vehicle's exhaust system in order to comply with the provisions of the bill. It is estimated this will require a one-time cost of \$2,600, which can be absorbed within VSP's current budget.
