Summary: The bill requires a magistrate to transmit the checklist for bail determination form within 24 hours to the attorney for the Commonwealth when a magistrate conducts a bail hearing for a person arrested on a warrant or capias for an act of violence. Transmission of such copy to the attorney for the Commonwealth may be by facsimile or other electronic means.
