4. Title: Health insurance; provider credentialing, receipt of application

Summary: The substitute bill requires carriers that accept applications through an online credentialing system to recognize notification to a new provider applicant through the online credentialing system that the provider has submitted and attested to the application as notice by the carrier that the application has been received. If the carrier does not accept applications through an online credentialing system, the carrier must, within 10 days of receiving an application, provide notification to the new provider applicant either by mail or electronic mail, as selected by the applicant, that the application was received.
