**2. Patron:** Williams

**3. Committee:** Senate Judiciary

**4. Title:** Acquisition and use of military property by law-enforcement agencies.

**5. Summary:** Changes the limitation on the acquisition or purchase of military property by a law enforcement agency from firearms of .50 caliber or higher to rifles of .50 caliber or higher. The bill also specifies law enforcement agencies are prohibited from acquiring or purchasing rifle ammunition of .50 caliber or higher.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** Indeterminate.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8 below.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The proposed legislation is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of State Police, the Division of Capitol Police, or the Department of Motor Vehicles. Any potential fiscal impact on other state law enforcement agencies or local law enforcement agencies is indeterminate at this time.
