3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: Virginia Freedom of Information Act; repeal; release of certain law-enforcement criminal incident.

5. Summary: Repeals § 2.2-3706.1, relating to the disclosure of law enforcement records pursuant to the Virginia Freedom of Information Act. The bill provides for the disclosure of criminal incident information relating to felony offenses, and lists the information that shall be included in response to such requests. Such information may be withheld until its release is not likely to cause damage to the investigation or prosecution, to compromise someone's safety, to cause a suspect to flee or evade detection, or to result in the destruction of evidence.
