4. Title: Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity; improvement plan for the one- stop small business permitting program.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity to develop a detailed improvement plan for the Department's one-stop small business permitting program and to provide the plan to the House Committees on Labor and Commerce and Appropriations and the Senate Committees on Commerce and Labor and Finance and Appropriations by November 1, 2022.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity, the department recently completed a study that addresses the components of the detailed plan required by this bill. The cost of the study was \$219,000, for which DSBSD used general fund appropriation in fiscal years 2021 and 2022. Completion of another study, in the event the one identified by the department is insufficient, would be similar. .
