3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Home care organizations; changes the license renewal requirement.

5. Summary: Changes the license renewal requirement for home care organizations from an annual renewal to a triennial renewal. The bill prohibits the Department of Health, upon renewal of a home care organization license, from requiring home care organizations to submit financial documents other than those required for initial licensure.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of the bill change the license renewal requirement for home care organizations from an annual renewal to a triennial renewal and that the fee for renewal of a home care organization license shall be \$1,500. The current renewal fee is \$500 annually, therefore, a \$1,500 fee for a triennial renewal is set sufficient to cover the provisions of the bill.
