**4. Title:** Board of Education; Child Care Subsidy Program; Armed Forces.

**5. Summary:** Directs the Board of Education (the Board) to examine its regulations and determine the feasibility of amending its regulations to permit all active duty members of the Armed Forces of the United States who serve as caregivers to dependents to apply for the Child Care Subsidy Program. The Board shall submit its findings to the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education and Health.
