Summary:** Authorizes the Cemetery Board to petition the court to appoint a receiver to oversee the cemetery operations of a cemetery company in certain situations, and provides that if the court appoints a receiver, the expenses of such receivership and a reasonable fee, as determined by the court, are to be paid from the assets of the cemetery company
