2. Patron: Kiggans

3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Voter registration; list maintenance; lists of decedents transmitted by State Registrar of Vital Records.

5. Summary: Requires the State Registrar of Vital Records to transmit to the Department of Elections a weekly list of decedents from the previous week. Currently, this list is transmitted monthly. The bill requires the general registrars to promptly cancel the registration of a person known to be deceased or otherwise disqualified to vote.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: As stand-alone legislation, the Department of Elections considers implementation of this bill as “routine,” and does not require additional funding. This bill is also not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Elections, State Board of Elections, Virginia Department of Health, and localities (General Registrars and Electoral Boards).

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: This version of the bill is identical to HB 55, as enrolled.
