4. Title: Children's Services Act; parent representatives; community policy and management teams.

5. Summary: The House substitute bill removes provisions that prohibit a parent representative from serving as a member of a community policy and management team (CPMT) or a family assessment and planning team (FAPT) if such parent representative is employed by a public or private program that receives funds pursuant to the law or agencies represented on a family assessment and planning team and interacts directly on a regular and daily basis with children or supervises employees who interact directly on a regular basis with children, however only if no other parent representative is available.
