**4. Title:** State correctional facilities; fees.

**5. Summary:** The enrolled bill requires the Department of Corrections (DOC) to convene a work group, consulting with all relevant stakeholders, to study the reduction or elimination of certain fees associated with inmates in state correctional facilities. A report of the work group's findings and recommendations must be presented to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Public Safety and the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services by October 1, 2022.
