3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Breeding dogs for certain research prohibited; penalty.

5. Summary: Prohibits a person who has received from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, pursuant to enforcement of the federal Animal Welfare Act (7 U.S.C. § 2131 et seq.) or regulations adopted thereunder, a citation for a direct or critical violation on or after July 1, 2023 from breeding or raising a dog for the purpose of selling or transferring the dog or cat, or its offspring, to an animal research facility outside of the United States, or to an animal research facility located in the United States that will use the animal for testing or research not required by federal law or regulation. The bill includes a delayed enactment clause requiring reenactment by the 2023 Session of the General Assembly.
