3. Committee: Commerce and Labor

4. Title: Health carriers; licensed athletic trainers.

5. Summary: Requires health insurers and health service plan providers whose policies or contracts cover services that may be legally performed by a licensed athletic trainer to provide equal coverage for such services when rendered by a licensed athletic trainer. This bill is a recommendation of the Health Insurance Reform Commission.
