4. Title: Department of Environmental Quality; issuance of issue certain permits.

5. Summary: Requires that the State Water Control Board amend regulations to provide that Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits may also be issued to an existing sewage treatment plant serving no less than 10 homes but no more than 25 homes, if such sewage treatment plant has a documented history of substantial noncompliance and it is not feasible to connect to a publicly owned sewage treatment plant.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). DEQ states this bill is anticipated to impact the Town of Occoquan. HB30/SB30 as introduced includes \$325,000 the first year from the general fund for the Town of Occoquan to complete outfall sediment projects and for stormwater dredging activities.
