3. Committee: Public Safety

4. Title: Local correctional facilities; fees.

5. Summary: The substitute bill requires the State Board of Local and Regional Jails (the Board) to convene a work group, to study the reduction or elimination of certain fees associated with inmates in local correctional facilities. The substitute bill requires that the work group include two members of the House Committee on Public Safety who are not members of the same political party and two members of the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services who are not members of the same political party. The substitute bill requires that the legislative members appoint other work group members who are representatives of incarcerated offenders and certain organizations or companies. A report of the work group's findings and recommendations must be presented to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Public Safety and the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services by October 1, 2022.
