4. Title: Local correctional facilities; fees.

5. Summary: The substitute bill requires the State Board of Local and Regional Jails (the Board) to convene a work group, consulting with all relevant stakeholders, to study the reduction or elimination of certain costs and fees charged to inmates in local or regional correctional facilities. A report of the work group's findings and recommendations must be presented to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Public Safety and the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services by October 1, 2022.
