3. Committee: Judiciary

4. Title: Military honor guards and veterans service organizations; paramilitary activities, exception.

5. Summary: Provides that members of a lawfully recognized color guard, honor guard, or similar organization, or a member of an officially recognized veterans service organization, are exempt from the prohibition in the Code against unlawful paramilitary activity when such member is participating in activities held by those organizations, unless such member engages in the activity with malicious intent.
