4. Title: Shared solar programs for electric utilities and electric cooperatives; reports.

5. Summary: The bill directs the State Corporation Commission to convene a stakeholder workgroup including representatives from the Department of Energy to evaluate shared solar programs for Phase I Utilities. The Commission is to report on its findings to the Chairmen of the Senate Commerce and Labor and the House Commerce and Energy Committees. Additionally, the Virginia, Maryland, and Delaware Association of Electric Cooperatives and the Coalition for Community Solar Access shall convene a stakeholder process to evaluate shared solar programs for electric cooperatives. Each report is due by November 30, 2022 and are to be posted on the Commission's website.
