4. Title: Virginia Board of Workforce Development; powers and duties; collaboration.

5. Summary: Directs the Virginia Board of Workforce Development to prepare recommendations for creating a primary office for apprenticeship programs.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that the Virginia Board of Workforce Development (the Board) can carry out the requirements of this bill with existing resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Community College System; Department of Education; Secretaries of Labor, Education, and Commerce and Trade; Department of Labor and Industry; Board of Workforce Development; Virginia Economic Development Partnership.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The bill requires that the Board work in collaboration with the Secretaries of Labor, Education, and Commerce and Trade, who are ex officio members of the Board. This bill is a companion to HB718.
