4. Title: Provisional teacher licensure; teachers licensed or certified to teach outside of United States.

Summary: Requires the Board of Education to provide for the issuance of a provisional license, valid for a period not to exceed three years, to any individual who holds a valid and officially issued and recognized license or certification to teach outside of the United States but does not meet the requirements for a renewable license.
