3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: Provisional teacher licensure; teachers licensed or certified to teach outside of United States.

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Education to provide for the issuance of a provisional license, valid for a period not to exceed three years, to any individual who has held within the last five years a valid and officially issued and recognized license or certification to teach issued by an entity outside of the United States but does not meet the requirements for a renewable license if the individual's license or certification to teach has been evaluated and verified by an entity approved by the department.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Education can absorb any costs associated with the issuance of additional provisional licenses that would result from this bill.
