4. Title: Towing.

5. Summary: The bill requires towing and recovery operators to provide the telephone number and website address with the Division of Consumer Counsel within the Office of the Attorney General on any invoice charging \$10,000 or more for the towing and recovery of a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of greater than 26,000 pounds, if the towing and recovery services are rendered pursuant to a lawful request for towing by an authorized law enforcement officer or other designated uniformed employee. Any towing and recovery operator who violates these provisions is subject to a civil penalty of \$1,000 per violation.
