3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Primitive campgrounds; sewer system and toilet requirements.

5. Summary: Directs the Department of Health to amend its regulations to exempt primitive campgrounds from the permanent sanitary facility requirements enumerated in relevant portions of the Virginia Administrative Code. The bill permits the Department to require primitive campgrounds to provide and maintain portable toilet facilities at the ratio of at least one toilet for every 75 campers and at least one toilet in compliance with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Minimal.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth or the Virginia Department of Health. Any fiscal impact to amend regulations can be handled within existing resources.
