2. Patron: Stanley

3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Primitive campgrounds; sewer system and toilet requirements.

5. Summary: Directs the Department of Health to amend its regulations to exempt primitive campgrounds from the permanent sanitary facility requirements in subsections A, B, and I of 12VAC5-450-100 of the Virginia Administrative Code. The Department may require primitive campgrounds to provide and maintain portable toilet facilities at the ratio of at least one toilet for every 75 campers and at least one toilet in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C § 12101 et seq.).

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Minimal.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this bill, as amended, would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth or the Virginia Department of Health. Any fiscal impact to amend regulations can be handled within existing resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: None.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: VDH can absorb the cost to promulgate regulations for the provisions of a single bill with existing resources. However, if a large number of bills become law with a requirement that VDH promulgate or modify regulations, then VDH indicates it will need additional resources to handle the increase in workload.
