2 *An Act to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-209.1 and 46.2-216 of the Code of Virginia, relating to certain*
3 *manufactured homes; release of manufactured home records.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That §§ 46.2-209.1 and 46.2-216 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 46.2-209.1. Release of vehicle information by Department to prospective vehicle purchasers.**

9 Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A of § 46.2-208, the Commissioner may furnish vehicle
10 information to a prospective purchaser of that vehicle, if the prospective purchaser completes an
11 application therefor, including the vehicle's make, model, year, and vehicle identification number, and
12 pays the fee prescribed by the Commissioner. Such information furnished by the Commissioner may be
13 provided from the Department's own records, or may be obtained by the Commissioner through the
14 National Motor Vehicle Title Information System or any other nationally recognized system providing
15 similar information.

16 *Notwithstanding the provisions of § 46.2-208, the Commissioner shall furnish vehicle information for*
17 *a manufactured home to a bona fide prospective purchaser or home owner of such manufactured home,*
18 *real estate agent, title insurer, settlement agent, attorney, manufactured home dealer, manufactured*
19 *home broker, or loan officer, provided that any requester completes an application therefor, provides*
20 *sufficient information to identify the manufactured home and the intent to purchase, and pays the fee*
21 *prescribed by the Commissioner. Such information furnished by the Commissioner may be provided from*
22 *the Department's own records or may be obtained by the Commissioner through the National Motor*
23 *Vehicle Title Information System or any other nationally recognized system providing similar*
24 *information.*

25 Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize the release of any personal information, driver
26 information, or special identification card information as defined in § 46.2-208.

27 **§ 46.2-216. Destruction of records.**

28 In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 7 (§ 42.1-76 et seq.) of Title 42.1, the Commissioner
29 may establish standards for the disposal of any paper or record which need not be preserved as a
30 permanent record. *However, the Department shall not dispose of any vehicle information, as defined in*
31 *§ 46.2-208, for any manufactured home.*
