6	A BILL to prohibit certain requirements regarding renewable energy certificates; priority of
7	procurement.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That in any proceeding pursuant to subsection C of § 56-585.5 of the Code of Virginia, each
10	Phase 1 Utility or Phase 2 Utility, as such terms are defined in subdivision A 1 of § 56-585.1 of the
11	Code of Virginia, shall prioritize procurement of renewable energy certificates (RECs) from renewable
12	energy standard sources (RPS eligible sources) located in the Commonwealth. Additionally, to promote
13	economic development in the counties and cities eligible for funding through the Tobacco Commission
14	Region Revitalization Commission, each utility shall include in its annual filing a plan for prioritizing
15	procurement of RECs from RPS eligible sources that are eligible for the Virginia Brownfield and Coal
16	Mine Renewable Energy Grand Fund and Program established pursuant to § 45.2-1725 of the Code of
17	Virginia.
