Choice of settlement agent. 14 A purchaser or borrower in a transaction related to real estate in the Commonwealth shall have the right to select the settlement agent to provide escrow, closing, or settlement services in connection with 15 the transaction. The seller in such a transaction may not require the use of a particular settlement agent 16 as a condition of the sale of the property. Nothing in this chapter shall prohibit a seller from retaining 17 an attorney licensed pursuant to Chapter 39 (§ 54.1-3900 et seq.) of Title 54.1 to represent his interests 18 and provide legal advice pertaining to escrow, closing, or settlement services. Such representation may 19

include deed preparation, fee negotiation, and review of applicable documents and advising the seller on

any legal matters related to the settlement or closing process.

2. That the provisions of this act are declarative of existing law.
