11	§ 46.2-869. Improper driving; penalty.	
12	A. A person may be charged with the offense of improper driving when his conduct is of the kind	
13	that constitutes reckless driving under this article but when his degree of culpability is slight.	
14	B. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this article, upon the trial of any person charged with	
15	reckless driving where the degree of culpability is slight, the court in its discretion may find the accused	
16	not guilty of reckless driving but guilty of improper driving. However, an attorney for the	
17	Commonwealth may reduce a charge of reckless driving to improper driving at any time prior to the	
18	court's decision and shall notify the court of such change.	

C. Improper driving shall be punishable as a traffic infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.
