| 9         | 1. That § 59.1-403 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:                        |
| 10        | § 59.1-403. Prohibition on persons under 21 years of age; penalty.                                     |
| 11        | No person shall wager on or conduct any wagering on the outcome of a horse race pursuant to the        |
| 12        | provisions of this chapter unless such person is eighteen 18 years of age or older. No person shall    |
| 13        | accept any wager from a minor. No person shall be admitted into a satellite facility if such person is |
| 14        | under eighteen 18 years of age unless accompanied by one of his parents or his legal guardian. No      |
| 15        | person under 21 years of age shall use any electronic gaming terminal or other electronic device in a  |
| 16        | satellite facility to wager on or conduct any wagering on historical horse racing. Violation of this   |
| <b>17</b> | section shall be a Class 1 misdemeanor.  |
