6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 58.1-3252 of the Code of Virginia, relating to real property tax,
7	assessment cycles.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 58.1-3252 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 58.1-3252. In counties.
11	There shall be a general reassessment of real estate every four years or, if determined by majority
<b>12</b>	vote of a county's board of supervisors, every three years. Any county that, however, has a total
13	population of 50,000 or less may elect by majority vote of its board of supervisors to conduct its
14	general reassessments at either five-year or six-year intervals. In addition, Augusta County and Bedford
15	County may elect by majority vote of their respective board of supervisors to conduct their general
16	reassessments at either five-year or six-year intervals.
<b>17</b>	Nothing in this section shall affect the power of any county to use the annual or biennial assessment
18	method as authorized by law.
